



The political situation in Honduras is affecting our partner Sociedad Amigos de los Niños (SAN) a great deal. Over the past month the country has been in turmoil after President Zelaya attempted to hold a non-binding referendum. The congress and Supreme Court deemed this as unconstitutional and the armed forces arrested and deported the President. There is no method for impeachment of a president in Honduras and this is the only legal way to remove him.

The situation is very unpredictable in Honduras, and a national curfew has been in effect. SAN is really feeling the effect of this political crisis. They have not received the funding they usually receive from their government, and are not able to pay their staff and keep up with their operating expenses.

The children in our village are safe and taken care of, thanks to our monthly child sponsors. SAN is so grateful to have your help, and happy to have so many friends in Canada supporting the children in Honduras.
